STATE OF CONNECTICUT ADDITIONAL VETERANS EXEMPTION AND CITY OF MILFORD LOCAL OPTION VETERANS EXEMPTION

State of Connecticut Additional Veteran income guideline is as follows:

- Single person's income <u>cannot</u> exceed \$43,800.
- Married couple's income <u>cannot</u> exceed \$53,400.

City of Milford Local Ordinance income guideline is as follows:

- Single person's income <u>cannot</u> exceed \$68,800.
- Married couple's income <u>cannot</u> exceed \$78,400.

How do I Apply?

The application filing period is **April 15, 2024 - September 15, 2024**Applications will be accepted between the hours of **9am-12pm and 2pm-4pm**. No appointment is needed.

What documents do I need to bring?

Applicants must bring proof of all income for the 2023 tax year.

Proof of income includes:

- A completed copy of your entire 2023 Federal tax return. (Include all schedules)
- Your original Social Security 1099 (SSA 1099) for the year 2023 (If married bring both 1099's) or Railroad Retirement earnings 1099 for the year 2023.
- If you do not file a tax return bring all your 1099 forms both taxable and nontaxable for the 2023 year. (i.e., Pensions, IRA's, interest, commissions, bonuses, lottery winnings, dividends, annuities, net rent, veteran pensions, and veteran disability pensions).
- All income from all sources for the 2023 calendar year must be considered for any tax relief program.

Failure to submit your application between **April 15**, **2024 – September 15**, **2024**, will result in losing Veteran exemption.
